


Grandsire Place Minimus



Purpose

Grandsire Place Minimus is a short, twin hunt method.

It provides an opportunity to practise making thirds over both hunt bells, just as with Grandsire on higher numbers.

It can be rung by a band who can plain hunt but who may have limited experience of method ringing.

Ringing Grandsire Place Minimus

Both the treble and second place bell plain hunt.

Third and fourth place bells alternate between making long fourths and thirds.

Third place bell starts by making one extra blow in thirds and hunting in.

Fourth place bell starts by making two extra blows in fourths and hunting in.

The bells making thirds will be ringing over both hunt bells.

Jargon

Twin hunt describes a method where two bells ring plain hunt continuously throughout the plain course of the method.
